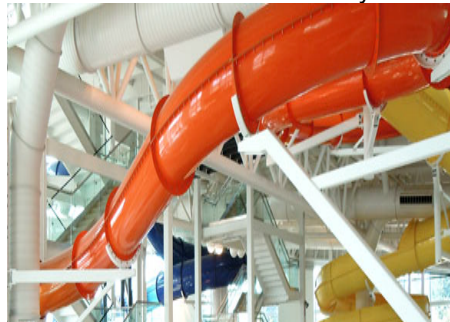

WINGS & WAVES WATER PARK GRAND OPENING JUNE 6th

The Wings and Waves educational water park is set to open June 6th on the Evergreen campus, which already includes Aviation and Space Museums, outdoor recreation areas and an IMAX theater. Grand Opening ceremonies lasting from 11 a.m. until 8 p.m. mark the 10th anniversary of the opening of the aviation museum. Wings and Waves will feature fun and educational exhibits focused on water, aviation and space. A children's museum and numerous interactive, educational exhibits

are designed to teach the power of water and its effects on society.



WATERPARK A MAJOR TOURIST ATTRACTION

At Evergreen Wings & Waves Waterpark children and adults will learn why "life needs water" through experience, inspiration and education. The waterpark is next to the museum, one of the greatest collections of aircraft and space artifacts in the world. Both the waterpark and the museum distinguish McMinnville as a premier location for learning about the power of science. At 70,000 square feet, the waterpark has a total of 10 waterslides and a wave pool. Plus, there is a café and rooms that can be rented for parties. The facility is highlighted

by a massive Evergreen Aviation B747-100 aircraft that rests on the top of the building.
